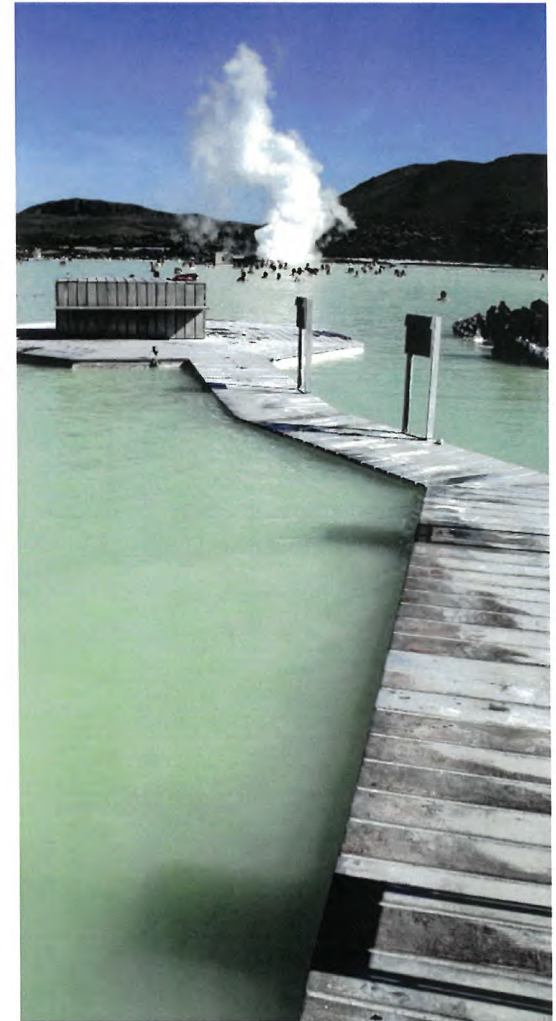

Calvert County Projects for the Assistance in the Transition from Homelessness (PATH)



PATH

The Calvert County PATH Program is designed to assist individuals who are homeless or at imminent risk of homelessness, and who struggle with mental health and/or substance use concerns. We are here to assist individuals in obtaining services and resources in order to live a healthy, self-directed life on their own PATH to housing, recovery and wellness.

Services Offered

Participants will have access to the following services and support

- Peer support sessions with a person in long term recovery.
- Referral to behavioral health resources within the community.
- Assistance in setting and achieving self directed recovery goals.
- Assistance in applying for benefits/entitlements to meet basic needs.
- Help with identifying and building a healthy support network.

PATH Expansion

The PATH Expansion is geared towards helping individuals who were at risk for homelessness and/or recently homeless maintain their new housing placement. The goal is to assist individuals with maintaining their housing, treatment requirements, and link them to resources within their community that could promote good health, productivity, and recovery.

Services Offered

Enrolled Participants will have access to assistance with maintaining their residence by way of these services:

- Applying for benefits/entitlements
- Assistance with learning how to pay household bills
- Role playing activities to build and/or maintain communication and people skills.
- Learn ways to cope with disorder(Physical, mental, or developmental)
- Assistance with building and/or maintaining support system.
- Linkage to community resources to meet basic needs.
